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WINNERS OF 2003 SECRETARY'S AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE IN ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION ANNOUNCED AT STATE HOUSE

Great Hall ceremony salutes winners from 45 towns across Massachusetts

As part of the annual Earth Day celebrations, Environmental Affairs Secretary Ellen Roy Herzfelder announced the winners of the ninth annual Secretary's Awards for Excellence in Environmental Education at a ceremony held today in the Great Hall of the State House. The Secretary's Awards are given to teachers and administrators who have made significant contributions to the field of environmental education in Massachusetts over the past year.

"I am pleased to report that environmental education is flourishing in our state's classrooms. This year's winners have shown unprecedented creativity and initiative in their programs and they should be commended for taking steps to create new generations of environmental leaders." The 48 winners of the 2003 Secretary's Awards represent 45 towns from across Massachusetts. Programs include: art projects, wetlands projects, recycling programs, biodiversity projects, environmental clubs, environmental studies courses and programs to reintroduce native species.

A total of \$5,000 was paid out to help nurture and sustain these programs in the coming year. Certificates of Excellence ranging from \$100 to \$300 were awarded for exemplary programs. Certificates of Merit and Certificates of Honor were also awarded.
